On Tuesday afternoon the staff-sergeants, &c., of the Isle of Wight Militia Artillery followed the remains of their late comrade in arms, Sergeant William Millgate, to Carisbrooke Cemetery. Major Buckle and Captain Pattinson joined the funeral at the cemetery. Capt. Graham, R.A., the adjutant, was not present, as he was absent on leave. Sergeant Millgate had seen much service, and experienced the severe hardships and privations of the Crimean War.
