Death of Mr. H.W. Morey, Sen. —The death took place on Monday, at the ripe age of 83, of Mr. W. H. Morey, sen., of Elm-Grove, an esteemed resident, well known in the Island as the head for many years of the firm Messrs. Morey and Sons, timber merchants, &c. He was a valued member of the Congregational Church, of which he was a deacon for a number of years. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday after-noon, the Rev. A. Stephens (Baptist) officiating. The principal mourners were the deceased's two sons, Messrs. H. W. Morey, T.C. (ex-Deputy Mayor), and Frank Morey, Mr .H. Steeple (son-in law), and Messrs. H. and F. Damp. Amongst those also attending were Messrs. Robey F. Eldridge, J.P., James Eldridge, James Thomas, J.P., C.A., Leonard Jordan, F. E. Witcher, T.C., C. J. Dashwood, J.
