The Late Mr. E. F. Morris. – The death occurred on Friday week at his home, 25 Collingwood Road, of Mr. Edwin Frederick Morris, aged 64. A native of London, Mr. Morris came to the Island as a child and served an apprenticeship as a baker with Messrs. Jolliffe at Hunnyhill. In 1904 he went to Whitecroft Hospital as baker and cook, later becoming kitchen superintendent. He retired in 1941. The funeral was at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Tuesday, the Rev. D. S. McKenzie (vicar) officiating. The mourners were Mrs. Morris (widow), Mr. E. F. Morris (son), Mrs. P. Poole (daughter), Mr. A. Morris (brother), Mrs. E. Norville and Miss A. Morris (sisters), Mrs. W. Willis (mother-in-law), and Mesdames C. Parsons and G. Ford, also representing Mr. Ford (sister-in-laws). W. O. E. E. T. Morris (son) was unable to attend. The arrangements were by Messrs. H. F.
