SUDDEN DEATH. - On Thursday, Mr. Blake, jun., as deputy-coroner, held an inquest at the Castle View Inn, Trafalgar-road, on view of the body of William Morris, a labourer, aged 64, who dropped dead on Wednesday afternoon, while employed in a hay field at Pan Farm, in the occupation of Mr. Hollis. Mr. Tuttiett, surgeon, of Pyle-street, was of opinion that deceased died from apoplexy, and a verdict to that effect was returned. The deceased with his family occupied a remarkably clean and neat little cottage, with its trim garden attached, in Elm Grove.
