DEATH OF MRS. G. NORMAN. - Sincere sympathy is felt with Mr. G. Norman, headmaster of the Barton Boys School, and formerly head-master of Carisbrooke Council School, and his daughter in the loss they have sustained by the death on Saturday of Mrs. Norman. The late Mrs. Norman had been a great sufferer during the last 18 months, and she underwent a serious operation at the County Hospital in August, 1933, and again last July. She was the daughter of the late Rev. James Morris, formerly of Sandown, and was a well known member of the Victoria Methodist Church. For several years she was a certificated teacher in the Island and for nearly four years was in the school at Chillerton, where Mr. Norman was the head-teacher. With her daughter, Mrs. Norman carried on a wool and art needlework business at 22 High-street, known as Norman's Repository.

The funeral took place on Tuesday, the first part of the service being held in the Victoria Methodist Church. The officiating ministers were the Revs. J. Matthewman and J. Higman. Mr. E.J.H. Quarrier was at the organ and played Mendelssohn's "But the Lord is mindful", "How lovely are the messengers", and "O rest in the Lord". The hymns sung were "Who fathoms the eternal thought" and "Jesus lives". The family mourners were Mr. G. Norman (husband), Miss E. G. Norman (daughter), Mr. E. J. Morris (brother), Miss M. L. Norman (sister-in-law), Mr. W. Endacott (brother-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. Cheater, Mrs. Ainley, Mrs. Cromer, and Mrs. N. Henton. Mrs. W. Symons (sister) and Mr. H. W. Norman (brother-in-law) were unable to attend owing to indisposition. Those also present included Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Croucher, Mrs. W. E. Kelly, Mrs. C. Read, Mrs. J. C. Collins, Mrs. W. H. Downer, Mrs. G. Gentle, Mrs. W. Wells, Mrs. Truscott, Mrs. J. L. Mitchell, Miss Fryer, Ald. J. H. Deacon, and Messrs. W. Ouseley, M.B.E., J.P., C.C., J. H. Brown, J.P., C.C., H. W. Horan, J. H. Morris, S. O. Feben, L. Wells, W. Warne (church steward), Wyatt, A. Morris (Rowborough), W. W. Flint, E. J. Kemp (Mrs. Kemp was unable to be present), A. Elderfield, T.C., and A. H. Hughes. The interment followed at Carisbrooke Cemetery. Mr. W. Wells carried out the arrangements.
