Death of Mr. W. S. North. – The death occurred on Monday at St. Mary's Hospital of Mr. Walter Sydney North, of 65 Trafalgar-road, aged 73. For a number of years he was employed as a storeman at North and Co's confectionary in Lugley-street. Prior to that he was in business in Trafalgar-road and postmaster at Carisbrooke. He was a devoted member of the P.S.A. Brotherhood. The funeral took place on Thursday in the Congregational Church, the Rev. T. E. R. Langridge officiated, and Mr. A. Mearnam (organist) accompanied the hymn "There is a land." The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. J. P. Jones, Mr. and Mrs. J. H. Loaring, and Mr. and Mrs. E. J. H. Baker (nephews and nieces) and Miss G.
