DEATH OF MR. FREDERICK NORTH. – The death occurred on Tuesday at Carisbrooke of Mr. Frederick North, aged 73, for over 23 years in business in Trafalgar-road, from which he retired some six months ago. He was an ardent worker in connection with the Newport Wesleyan Church and had been a local preacher since the age of 18. He was also a strong advocate of temperance and was one of the oldest members of the Sons of Temperance at Reading, his native town. He was held in the highest esteem, and much sympathy is felt with the widow in her loss after 55 years of wedded life, and with members of the family. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Friday, the Rev. W. H. Spencer (Cowes) officiating. Those present, in addition to the family mourners, were Messrs. E. H. F. Payne, Percy Williams, W. Wells, A. Elderfield, C. J. Dashwood, W. Goodman, and W. Spooner.
