SOLDIER'S WIDOW'S PATHETIC DEATH. – The death occurred on Saturday, after a short illness, at 23 New-street, of Mrs. Milsie Oram, widow of Pte. S.J. Oram, Dorset Regiment, at the age of 29. Deceased's husband was dangerously wounded in France, and died shortly after reaching a hospital at Portsmouth on the first anniversary of their wedding day. Mrs. Oram was then well, and visited her husband in hospital, but the shock of his death proved too much for her, and four days after his funeral she died practically of a broken heart. She was laid to rest on Wednesday side by side with her late husband, at Carisbrooke Cemetery. There were many lovely floral tributes, including a wreath from the St. Thomas's Women's Bible Class, of which deceased was a member, Mr. O. Hamilton was the undertaker.
