Licensee's Death. – After several months' illness the death took place last week of Mr. Harold Lewellen Owen, aged 54, who had been the licensee of the Bugle Tap, Lugley-street. Mr. Owen came to the Island some 16 years ago and for about 10 years was employed by Mr. Reg. Wells. He was a member of the branch of the British Legion and leaves a widow, two sons, and a daughter. The funeral was at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Friday week, the Rev. H. Ewbank officiating. The mourners were Mrs. Owen (widow), Mr. R. and Master C. Owen (sons), and Miss J. Owen (daughter). The floral tributes included a wreath from friends of the Bugle Tap.
