OBITUARY. – The death occurred early on Saturday morning, at the age of 41, of Mrs. Sarah Fanny Peck, wife of Mr. Alfred Peck, the well-known and respected host of the Britannia, Hunnyhill. The deceased had been suffering from consumption for a considerable time, but the end came rather suddenly at last. The late Mrs. Peck was a member of the congregation of St. John's Church and was much esteemed, and the utmost sympathy is felt with Mr. Peck and his family in their irreparable bereavement. The funeral took place on Wednesday afternoon at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Rev. F.J. Pitts officiating. The principal mourners were the husband and four sons, Messrs. G. Harding (brother), Fred and Edward Peck, F. Shields, W. Bulstrode (brothers-in-law), W. Coffin (uncle), B. Jolliffe, and T. Young (cousins). Others present were Mr. Charles J. Dashwood, Messrs. J. Grisley, Mitchell, H. Harris, and others. Messrs. J. Morgan, J. Lamb, Groves, and E.J. Edgar, friends of the family, were the bearers. The polished oak coffin was covered with beautiful floral tributes from "Her sorrowing husband and children – 'Peace, perfect peace'". Mr. O. Hamilton was the undertaker.
