The Deaths of Mr & Mrs Pinhorn

In Death Not Divided.—The death occurred at Elm Bank, Watergate-Road, on Tuesday last, of Mrs Pinhorn, the wife of Mr. C. H. Pinhorn, who had attained the ripe age of 85. The deceased's husband, who was well known by the older residents of Newport, did not long survive his wife, passing away two days later at the age of 73. Mr Pinhorn was formerly for some years headmaster of the Tenbury National-school, Worcestershire, coming to Newport some 30 years ago, where he has lived ever since in retirement. The funeral of Mrs. Pinhorn took place at noon yesterday (Friday) at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Rev. J. Warren Danford officiating. The principal mourners were Messrs. Henry, Frank, Harry, Percy, Arthur, and Willie Shepherd, Mr. R. Roach Pittis, J. P., Mr. F. Morgan, T.C., and Mr. E. G. H. Wetherick.
