DEATH OF MR. JOSEPH POORE. – We have to record the death of Mr. Joseph Poore, who passed away on Sunday evening last, at the ripe age of 85 years. He had been in business in Newport for the long period of 56 years, and he always maintained a character for the strictest uprightness and integrity, commanding the respect of all who knew him. Highly skilled in his business, in early days he went to Gibraltar, where he was engaged upon Government works, and he loved to recall reminiscences of his life on the Rock. He was for many years a member of the Corporation of Newport, and he also had a seat on the Carisbrooke Burial Board, to which he was re-elected so recently as last Easter.
