SUDDEN DEATH OF AN OLD EMPLOYE. – Early on Saturday morning last Mr. George Glazier [sic] Powell, engineer at the West Medina Cement Works, where he had been employed for some 44 years, died suddenly on the 56th anniversary of his birthday. The Coroner was communicated with, but he did not consider an inquest necessary. Deceased was very much respected. The funeral took place on Wednesday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, deceased's fellow-workmen acting as bearers. The many floral tokens of respect included wreaths from the firm of Messrs. Francis, Son, and Co., the staff, and the workmen
