The Late Mrs. A. Rackett. – The funeral service for Mrs. Elizabeth R. A. Rackett, of 39, New Street, took place at Carisbrooke on Thursday week. Mrs. Rackett died the previous Monday at her home shortly before reaching her 93rd birthday. She was the widow of Mr. Alfred Rackett, who died of injuries received in the air raid on the town in 1943. Mrs. Rackett had resided here for 47 years and was well known as a member of the Darby and Joan Club, St. John's Mother's Union and the Quay Street Sisterhood, which she regularly attended until a few years ago. The Rev, W. H. Read, Methodist, officiated at the service. The mourners were Mr. H. Morey (son-in-law), Mrs. W. Bonham (daughter), Mrs. R. Flux (grand-daughter) and Mr. Flux, Mr. J. Bonham (grandson) and Mrs. Bonham and Mr. and Mrs. Cheverton. Mrs. Morey (daughter) was unable to attend through illness. Floral tributes included one from neighbours and friends.
