DEATH OF MISS MURIEL RICH. – Deep and general sympathy with Mr. and Mrs. G. D. Rich, of Marl Hill, Carisbrooke, has been evoked by the death of their youngest daughter, Muriel May, who passed away on Tuesday evening, at the age of 14 years. The deceased was in the town on the Saturday previous to her death, on the Sunday she was poorly, on Monday she was better and on the lawn of Marl Hill, and it was only on Tuesday morning that the existence of anything serious became apparent. Drs. Coombs and Foster were called in, and their opinion being that only an operation could save the patient, as she was suffering from appendicitis, specialists in London and Ryde were communicated with by telephone on Tuesday evening, but before there could be any response to these summonses the angel of death “visited the green earth and took the flower away.” The late Muriel Rich was an exceptionally bright and sympathetic girl, full of life and animation, and her death is deeply mourned by many friends, young and old. The funeral takes place at Carisbrooke Cemetery this (Saturday) afternoon at 2.30.
