RYDE.

CUT FINGER LEADS TO DEATH. – The death, under strange circumstances, is reported from the I.W. County Hospital, of Lucy Salter, wife of Andrew Salter, labourer, of Elm Grove, Newport. It appears that on the 6th December the deceased, whilst throwing some broken glass into the grate, cut her finger through striking the iron. This developed blood poisoning, and Dr. Castle, of Newport, was consulted, and the finger went on fairly well under poultices until the 13th, when it turned very much worse and she was taken to the Infirmary at Ryde; but on Friday the decease took a bad turn, and on Saturday morning, between one and two, death occurred. The facts were communicated to the Coroner who, however, considered an inquest unnecessary.
