### DEATH OF MR. J. SANDERS, C.C.

We record with regret the death of Mr. Joseph Sanders, C.C., of Carisbrooke, which took place after several weeks' illness on Monday last at the age of 68. The deceased had for many years prominently identified himself with the public life of Carisbrooke. He represented the parish for a considerable time on the Board of Guardians, and proved himself one of its most useful members. He was also for some time a Highway Commissioner for his parish; he was a member of the Carisbrooke Burial Board; he served the office of overseer of the parish on several occasions; and he represented his parish on the County Council since that body came into existence. He was also an active member of the I.W. Chrysanthemum Society, to which his practical knowledge proved of great service, and one of the oldest deacons of the Newport Congregational Church. Politically, the deceased was a staunch Liberal. He was highly respected by all classes in Carisbrooke, as well as by all who knew him, and as general will be the regret felt at his death. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday afternoon, the Rev. A. O. Lochere officiating. In addition to the family mourners those present at the obsequies included Messrs. H. W. Morey, jun., J. Thomas, G. M. Brown, H. Harvey, and F. Morgan (representing the Newport Congregational Church), Dr. Groves, J.P., and Mr. Horace Groves (representing the I.W. Chrysanthemum Society), Messrs. R. Pinnock, J.P. (chairman of the Burial Board), W. C. Way, J.P., W. Spickernell, J. E. Snellgrove, J. G. Johnson, G. Fellows, C.C., E. G. Barnes, T. H. Midlane, W. Turner, R. Noyce (Cowes), F. A. Turner (Carisbrooke School Board), and others. The coffin bore the inscription "Joseph Sanders, died April 16<sup>th</sup>, 1894, aged 68 years". Amongst the beautiful floral tributes was a wreath bearing the inscription "From the committee of the Isle of Wight Chrysanthemum Society, with the respectful regrets of his colleagues".
