Death of Mr. J. Sanders.— The death occurred on Monday at St. Elmo, Watergate, of Mr. James Sanders, late of Carisbrooke. The deceased was the eldest son of the late Mr. Joseph Sanders, and was of a somewhat retiring, but cheerful, disposition, and made many friends. He was formerly a pupil of Portland House Academy, and was well known in the market gardening trade, from which he retired nearly three years ago owing to ill-health. For five years he was an overseer of the parish. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday. The Rev. R. Sirhowy Jones officiated. At the wish of the deceased, the first part of the service was held at St. Elmo. The mourners were the widow, Mr. W. J. Sanders (son), the Misses M. L. H. and N. Sanders (daughters), Mr. B. Sanders, C.C., and Police-Inspector F. Sanders (brothers), Mr. C. Stevens (brother-in-law), Mr. F. Turner, Mr. R. Turner (nephew), and Messrs. H. Stephens, J. Sanders, J. Pike, G. Trueman, and W. Thompson, C.C. (cousins). Those also present included his colleagues, Messrs. L. C. Attrill and F. Hayter (overseers), W. H. Wadham (assistant overseer), H. Cross, W. Coster, and J. Kerley, and Mr. G. Long (Messrs. Roach Pittis and Co.). There were many beautiful floral tributes. The funeral arrangements were carried out by Messrs. H. and F. Damp.
