OBITUARY. – It is our painful task to have to record the death of Mrs. Isabella Fanny Saunders, widow of the late Mr. George Saunders and daughter of Mrs. Morris of Upper Rill Farm, where her death occurred on Saturday last at the early age of 42 years. It is only about three months ago that the family were bereaved by the death of a still younger daughter (the late Mrs. Linington, of Newchurch), and the sincere sympathy of a large circle of friends and neighbours is with them in their present sorrow. The funeral took place on Wednesday last at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the burial service being read by the Vicar (the Rev. A.W. Milroy), this being, we believe, the first instance on record of the Vicar taking the burial service in the Nonconformist portion of the Cemetery. The coffin was of polished elm and was covered with beautiful floral tributes, and among those following the remains to the grave were Mr. A. Morris (Rill), brother, Mr. Morris (Newport), Mr. F. Linington and Mr. Weeks (East Cowes Castle), brothers-in-law, Mr. H. Morris, nephew, Mr. G. Henton (Loverstone), Mr. Morris (Pan), Mr. Andrew Morris (Billingham), Mr. H.M. Morris (Kingston), Dr. Groves, J.P., and others. Mr. King of Blackwater, had charge of the funeral arrangements.
