**DEATH OF MRS. GEORGE SHEATH.** – With regret we have to record the death of the wife of our respected townsman, Mr. George Sheath, of Vale Meade, Carisbrooke-road, which occurred last Monday, at the age of 68. The deceased lady had been in indifferent health for some considerable time, but of late there had been some indications of improvement, and the end came quite unexpectedly, bronchial asthma being the cause of death. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday, the service being performed by the Rev. A.W. Milroy, vicar of Carisbrooke. The husband was prevented by illness from attending, and he was represented by his brother (Mr. F. Sheath), the other mourners including Capt. de Lisle (brother-in-law of the deceased) and Mr. Mitchell (cousins). Amongst others following were Mr. J. Stanley and Mr. Harry Shepard. There were a number of floral tokens of regard and sympathy.
