

## Frank Emanuel Snow

### NEWPORT.

**Death of Mr. F. E. Snow.** – Mr. Frank Emmanuel [*sic?*] Snow, aged 76, late of 3 York-road, died on Tuesday, at Upper Norwood, London. Mr. Snow was secretary of Messrs. H. W. Morey and Son, timber merchants, from the time the firm became a limited company until February, 1942, when he retired, and had lived in London for the last two years. He was keenly interested in the natural history of the Island, and for many years was treasurer of the I.W. Natural History and Archaeological Society. In the Great War he held a commission in the Volunteer Training Corps. He is survived by two sons. His sister, Miss Jane Snow, of 6 Hearn-street, is 96 years of age. The funeral takes place to-day (Saturday) at Carisbrooke Cemetery, preceded by a service in St. Thomas's Church at 3 p.m.

### NEWPORT.

**Funeral of Mr. F. E. Snow.** – The interment took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Saturday of Mr. Frank Emmanuel [*sic?*] Snow, aged 76, who, until his retirement in 1942, was for many years secretary of Messrs. Morey and Sons, timber merchants. Canon W. B. Hogg (vicar of Newport) officiated, and the interment was preceded by a service at St. Thomas's Church. The principal mourners were Messrs. W. A. and W. K. Snow (sons), J. B. Alderslade and G. Attrill (brothers-in-law), F. Attrill (nephew) and Mrs. Attrill, Mr. W. S. Warne, and the Messrs M., H., and E. Snow. Among others present were the Mayor (Mr. A. E. King, C.C.), Messrs. H. H. Gould (managing director) and A. B. Gould (director), of Messrs. Morey and Sons, also representing Mr. F. B. Baker, Messrs. G. N. Rogers, J.P. (formerly foreman), R. G. Lane, L. and F. Church, W. Saunders, V. Pitman, L. J. Williams, G. and A. Denham, W. Wearn, W. Freeman, and H. Green (staff of Morey and Sons), Messrs. W. G. Sibbick, J.P., A. D. Calloway, N. G., and C. V. Cheverton (secretary), of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows, O. G. Day (Messrs. J. K. Alderslade, Ltd.), F. A. Linington (Messrs. H. and F. Damp), R. J. Eldridge, G. S. Hibberd, S. L. Woodland, P. W. Boxall, H. Hollis, S. E. Whildey (Ventnor), W. Watson, F. Baker, and J. A. Mabb, Mr. and Mrs. R. Parsons (Cowes), Mr. and Mrs. C.
