Funeral of Mr. J. Snudden.— The remains of Mr. James Snudden, secretary of the Isle of Wight District of Foresters, and secretary of Court Island Foresters, 1821, were interred at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Sunday afternoon. Notwithstanding the inclement weather, snow falling thickly at the time, a long procession of Foresters and Oddfellows followed on foot. These included representatives of Courts “Providence” (Ventnor), “Foresters’ Isle” (Cowes), and “Harmony” (Shanklin); the P.D.C.R. of the I.W. District of Rechabites, and brethren of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows, Newport. There were several carriages, the number of followers being about 250. Court Island Foresters sent a splendid floral wreath (supplied from Covent Garden through Mr. Cave), and beautiful floral tributes were sent from Court Foresters’ Isle, and Court Year (Yarmouth). The banner of Court Island Foresters covered the coffin as a pall. The burial service was conducted by the Rev. A. O. Lochore, and the service of the Order of Foresters was read by the Chief Ranger of the Court, Bro. Dyer.
