OBITUARY. – The death occurred on Saturday of Mr. Charles Tosdevin, who for nearly 50 years was in business here as a carpenter and undertaker. The deceased had a fine record of 27 years' service in the old Volunteers, which he joined in 1873. He was one of the best shots in Hampshire, having won many prizes. He had been a member of the Carisbrooke Parish Council almost since its formation and of the Carisbrooke and Gatcombe Garden Society from the beginning, and was chairman of the Burial Board. The funeral took place on Thursday at the Cemetery, the first part of the service being held at the United Methodist Chapel, Gunville. In addition to the family, there were present Insp. H. Sibbeck and Mrs. Sibbeck and Messrs. Varney and Berthram, the members of the Parish Council, the Cottage Garden Society, and the Burial Board, and Messrs. B. Sanders, C.C., A. Barnes, A. Bryant, E. R. Dore, and A. Peck. Wreaths were sent, in addition to the family, by the Parish Council and the Cottage Garden Society. The Rev. T. Letcher read the Burial Service, and Messrs. H. and F. Damp carried out the arrangements.
