**DEATH OF MR. GEORGE H. VINCENT.** – The lamented death from pneumonia following influenza occurred on Thursday at his home, Carisbrooke, of Mr. George H. Vincent, aged 43. The deceased had been practically all his life employed in the grocer's shop of the late Mr. K. Clark, Nodehill, and his service was continued under Mr. W. W. Clark, the present proprietor. He was, for many years, a very valued worker for the Conservative cause, and, both in business and in social life, his unflinching cheeriness and courtesy gained him many friends, whose deepest sympathy is with the widow in her irreparable bereavement. His only son served with the I.W. Rifles at Gallipoli, from which he was invalided to England with illness, to which he succumbed just before reaching home.
