### NEWPORT.

DEATH OF MR. EDWARD WARREN, - The death occurred on Monday, at the ripe age of 84, of Mr. Edward Warren, who spent the greater part of his long life in this town, where he was held in warm regard by all with whom he came into contact. He formerly held office under the Guardians as vaccination officer, and was also Inland Revenue collector. When Newport returned members of its own to the House of Commons, Mr. Warren was very familiar in Liberal circles, the consistency with which he maintained his political principles being only equalled by the unfailing good humour which he always exhibited. Even when party feeling ran very high, and when opposing partisans looked “daggers” at each other, Edward Warren always came up with a smile. Up to a week or two of his death he was seen in our streets, though he never recovered from the shock occasioned him more than a year ago by the death of the loved partner of his long life. On one occasion recently he was asked what his opinion was on the fiscal question, and the old man replied, “The fiscal question has no interest for me,” smilingly adding that he was shortly going where there were no taxes. The funeral took place yesterday at Carisbrooke Cemetery.
