Death of Mr. J.H. Wavell. – The death occurred on Thursday at St. Mary's Hospital of Mr. Joseph Henry Wavell, of 23 Avondale-road, at the age of 83. His death removes one of the best known of Newport inhabitants. Mr. Wavell was born at the Vine Inn, which belonged to his family for generations, and he lived there until about 20 years ago, when the premises were sold to Messrs. Brickwood, of Portsmouth. Mr. Wavell was interested in most sports, especially shooting. After his retirement from the licensing trade Mr. Wavell established the Enterprise Bus Service with his son, Mr. M.J. Wavell. He was a member of the Newport Literary Society and the Conservative Club. The funeral will take place at St. John's Church at 12.30 p.m. to-morrow (Sunday).
