DEATH OF MR. ROBERT WAY. – We regret to record the death of Mr. Robert Way, of Carisbrooke-road, Newport, who passed peacefully hence at Ventnor on Sunday last, at the age of 71. The deceased years ago held an influential commercial position in the Island, and in later years he had efficiently filled official appointments under the Board of Guardians. Himself a member of an old Island family, he was connected with other families of long standing, and he was held in high respect by a wide circle of friends. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday, the Rev. A. W. Milroy, vicar of Carisbrooke, officiating. The mourners included Mr. Richard Way, Mrs. Dillon, Miss Rebecca Way, Mr. Temple Way, Mr. Francis T. Mew, J.P., C.C., Dr. Stanley Foster, Miss Parker, Miss Chamberlain, Mr. Charles B.
