Death of Miss M. Wigmore. – Many former pupils of Westmont School, as well as a large number of townsfolk will learn with regret, of the death at Westmont School, after a short illness, on Sunday, of Miss Margaret Ormsby Wigmore. Miss Wigmore, who was 90 years of age, had been connected with the school for many years, until advancing years caused her to relinquish active work. Besides teaching painting and drawing, she took a special interest in the kindergarten. Miss Wigmore's niece, Miss M. Wigmore, is now joint principal of the school with Miss Milner. She was the last surviving daughter of Mr. Wm. Wigmore, of Ballynona, County Cork. The funeral took place on Wednesday, and was conducted by members of the Brethren meeting in Clarence-road, and the interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The mourners were Miss M. D. Wigmore and Miss R. Roberts (nieces) and Miss A. Milner, A. Lock, and E. M. Goatley. Friends also attended from various parts of the Island and mainland.
