OBITUARY. – We record with regret the death of an old tradesman of this town in the person of Mr. Henry Williams, of Carisbrooke-road. Deceased, who had reached the age of 71, succumbed to a painful illness on Saturday last. Of a quiet and retiring disposition, the deceased gentleman had won the esteem of all with whom he came in contact. He was a staunch Liberal of the old school and a member of the Wesleyan Church. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday afternoon in the presence of relatives and personal friends, the Rev. N. Kelynack officiating. There were many signs of mourning in the district where deceased had lived so long. The coffin was of polished elm, with raised lid and brass mounts, and Mr. S. Chiverton carried out the funeral arrangements.
