The Late Mr. H. J. Amies. – The funeral took place on Monday of Mr. Herbert John Amies, of 21 St. John's Road, who died on Wednesday week at the Royal I.W. County Hospital, aged 69. A native of Birmingham, Mr. Amies first came to the Island 38 years ago, while he was serving with the Royal Warwickshire Regiment as a transport-sergeant. He was posted to India, where he was transferred to the Somerset Light Infantry. On completing 21 years' service he retired from the army and joined the Indian Police. Later he became chief inspector of the Port Trust of Bombay. He returned here in 1939, after being 15 years with the Port Trust. He was a member of the Beatrice Lodge of Buffaloes. The Vicar (the Rev. S. F. Cooper) officiated at the service at St. John's Church. The mourners were Mrs. N. Amies (widow), Mr. and Mrs. H. J. Amies (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. S. J. Carpenter (son-in-law and daughter), Mrs. N. Goodwin (sister), and Master Richard Amies (grandson). Miss G. Amies (daughter) was unable to attend. Cremation took place at Southampton. The floral tributes included one from friends in St. John's Road. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements,
