DEATH OF MRS. I. GOLDEN. — The death occurred on Thursday week, at The Bays, of Mrs. Anne Golden, widow of Ald. Isaac Golden, at the ripe age of 91. The late Mrs. Golden is pleasantly remembered for her estimable qualities by the older towns-people and Islanders, her late husband having been a valued member of the Corporation and principal partner for many years in the formerly well-known firm of Messrs. Golden and Vibert, of the High-street. The funeral took place at the Old Cemetery, Southampton, on Monday, the simple service in the cemetery chapel being conducted by the deceased's son, the Rev. Stanley Golden. The mourners were Messrs. Harry, Newton, Frank, and Howard Golden (sons), Mrs. H. J. Way (Newport) and Mrs. Newington (daughters), and Mrs. New (Newport). Major H. J. Way was prevented by indisposition from attending. There were many beautiful floral tributes.
