The Late Mrs. E. Guy - Members of the Congregational Church, where she had been an active worker for many years, will learn with regret of the death on Monday of Mrs. Elizabeth Guy, of 55 Elm Grove. Mrs. Guy, who was in her 86th year, was a well-loved figure in her circle of friends made in the last 24 years since she came to the town with her husband, the late Mr. Frederick William Guy. Her keen interest in the church was shown in her work for the Pleasant Thursday Evening meetings, of which she was a former vice-president. A native of Shropshire, her father, the late Mr. S. Hayward, was a well-known farmer and Methodist local preacher in the villages around Shrewsbury, Mr. and Mrs. Guy came to the Island from Ringwood, where Mr. Guy was employed with an engineering firm, and he joined the staff of Leigh Thomas and Co., Ltd., as a master millwright. They were both trained singers and in Ringwood singing was one of their chief interests. Mrs. Guy, who had been a widow since 1964, recently made the journey alone to her relatives in Shropshire. She is survived by two of her four children. Cremation took place at Southampton on Wednesday. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. R. Guy, of Brighstone (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. W. Stapleton (son-in-law and daughter), and Mr. and Mrs. J. Betts, with whom Mrs. Guy shared her home (nephew and niece), and Miss R. Guy (sister-in-law). The arrangements were made by Messrs.
