Death of Mrs. R. H. Appleton.--The death occurred on Saturday at St. Mary's Hospital of Mrs. Charlotte Appleton, aged 83, of 45 Quay Street. A native of the town, Mrs. Appleton was the oldest member of the Victoria Sisterhood. She had been married for about 65 years and her husband, Mr. Thomas Henry Appleton, also a Newportonian, is well known in the town. The funeral service on Wednesday at the Quay Street Methodist Church was conducted by the minister (the Rev. G. L. W. Ridge). Mr. W. G. Bartlett, at the organ, accompanied the hymn "Jesu, Lover of my Soul." The mourners were Mr. T. H. Appleton (husband), Mr. and Mrs. A. T. Appleton (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. P. Appleton (son), Mr. and Mrs. F. Thomas and Mr. and Mrs. L. Plumbley (sons-in-law and daughters), Mrs. I. Plumbley (daughter), and grandchildren and nieces. Interment followed at Newport Cemetery.
