Retired Dentist's Death. --- The death occurred at his home, 48 High Street, on Monday, of Mr. Robert Henry Archer, aged 78, who was well-known as a dentist. Mr. Archer was born in Cambridge and came to the Island 35 years ago. He was a vice-president of the East Cowes Conservative Club and a member of the Newport Conservative Club. A keen bowls player, he was a former member of the Newport club. He retired from practice about four years ago because of ill-health. The funeral service, which took place on Thursday at the Parish Church, was conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. C. R. Farnsworth). The chief mourners were Mrs. M. H. Archer (widow), Mrs. R. C. Flitton (daughter), Mr. and Mrs. J. B. Archer (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. P. T. Archer (son), and Mr. S. W. Twyman. Miss A. M. Archer (sister), Dr. H. E. Archer (brother) and Mr. R. C. Flitton (son-in-law) were unable to attend. The East Cowes and Newport Conservative clubs were represented. The interment was at Newport Cemetery. The arrangements were made by Messrs. H. and F.
