**Death of Mrs. C. Ashton.**-----The death took place on Wednesday week at 13 St. John`s-road, at the age of 89, of Mrs. Charlotte Ashton. Before her retirement three years ago Mrs. Ashton was the proprietress of a seed and florist business in Pyle-street and was well known in the town. She had been associated with the business for over 70 years. Her husband died in 1923 and she leaves a son. Mrs. Ashton was one of the oldest members of the Wesleyan Church and a member of the Wesleyan Sisterhood. The funeral was on Saturday at Pyle-street Methodist Church. The Rev. H. J.
