Former Resident's Death. The funeral service took place at the Parish Church on Wednesday for Mr. Frederick John Bishop, aged 90, formerly of Newport, who died at his home, 152 Gudge Heath Lane, Fareham, the previous Friday. Mr. Bishop, who was born in the town, lived for many years at Odessa, Blackhouses, near the river, where his father and brother had a boat-building business. During his youth Mr. Bishop was closely associated with St. John's Church. He was an insurance salesman, whose work frequently took him away from the Island. He went to live in Fareham over 20 years ago. The Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley officiated, assisted by the Rev. C. Bryant, of Holy Trinity, Fareham. The 23rd Psalm (Crimond) was sung. The mourners included Mrs. O. Bishop (widow), Mr. J. Bishop (son), Mr. and Mrs. C. H. Grist (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. D. Grist and Mr. M. Grist (grandchildren). Interment was at Newport Cemetery. The arrangements were made by Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and R. G. W. Reed.
