AGRICULTURAL WORKER'S DEATH

The death occurred on Wednesday week of Mr. Ernest Albert George Brown, aged 63, of Greenhills Farm. Mr. Brown, who was the son of Mrs. and the late Mr. C.G. Brown, was born at Wroxall. He has been employed in agricultural work all his life and for the last 18 years had been working for Mr. and Mrs. G.W. Griffin, of Great Briddlesford Farm, Wootton, who also own Greenhills Farm. He had been a member of the Rechabites for 47 years, and of Quay Street Methodist Church, Newport. The funeral took place on Saturday, the service at the Victoria Methodist Church being conducted by the Minister of the Quay Street Methodist Church (the Rev. Dr. W.H. Mildon). The hymns "The Lord's My Shepherd" and "Rock of ages" were sung. The mourners were Mrs. E. Brown (Widow), Mr. and Mrs. W. Griffin and Mr. and Mrs. A. Guy (brothers-in-law and sisters), Mr. and Mrs. A. Brown and Mr. and Mrs. W. Brown (brothers and sisters-in-law), Mr. D. Griffin, Mrs. Capon, and Miss A Brown (nephew and nieces), Messrs G. C.
