DEATH OF MRS. S. BURTON. The death occurred on Saturday, at 146 High-street, of Mrs. Sarah Burton, in her 87th year. She was the widow of Mr. A. N. Burton, formerly of Cavendish-place, who was employed by Messrs. Gould, Hibberd, and Randall as a foreman for about 50 years. Mrs. Burton was a member of the P.T.E. and the Holyrood Women's Class, and was held in much esteem. The funeral service was on Thursday in the Congregational church, the Rev. T.E.R. Langridge officiating. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. W.A. Hayles (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. F.G. and Mr. and Mrs. A.S. Burton (sons and daughters-in-law), Mr. C. Burton (son), Mr. G. Burton (nephew), and Mrs. P. Wray (niece). Others present included Mr. F.E. Welsh and representatives of the P.T.E. and the Holyrood Women's Class. The floral tributes included those from the P.T.E. and the Holyrood Women's Class. The interment was at Newport Cemetery. Mr. W.W. Wells was the undertaker.
