PARKHURST NONAGENARIAN'S DEATH. – The death occurred yesterday (Friday) morning at 15 Worsley-road, Hunnyhill, of Ellen, widow of Mr. T. Cole, of High-street, Newport, who had reached the grand old age of 92. Mrs. Cole enjoyed remarkably good health until five weeks ago, when she fell downstairs. She escaped serious injury, but the shock of the occurrence confined her to bed, and bronchial trouble followed. She was one of four daughters of the late Frederick Stark, a former well-known farmer at Hunnyhill, who until a year ago resided within a stone's throw of each other at Hunnyhill, and whose ages at that time averaged 80. The first of the venerable quartet to die was Mrs. Willis, who was in her 81st year. Two sisters, Mrs. Cooper and Miss Stark, remain, and both are approaching octogenarian honours.
