The Late Mr. F. H. G. Croucher.- The funeral took place at St. Paul's Church on Friday week of Mr. Frederick Henry George Croucher, aged 61, of 30a, Holyrood Street, who died at the Royal I.W. County Hospital, Ryde. Mr. Croucher was born in Newport and educated at Barton School. For a number of years he worked for Arthur Wood, Ltd., agriculturalists and ironmongers, who were taken over by Messrs. SCATS in 1964. He was then employed by Messrs. SCATS until his retirement through ill-health a week before his death. During the Second World War Mr. Croucher served with Carisbrooke Home Guard. The Rev. W. Boardman officiated. The mourners were Mrs. Croucher (widow), Mr. and Mrs. L. Newnham and Mr. and Mrs. F. Day (brothers-in-law and sisters), Mr. K. Day (nephew), Mrs. E. Thorne (niece), Miss F. Bailey, Mrs. P. Peachey, Mrs. K. B. Gustar and Mr. and Mrs. G. Siggery (brother-in-law and sisters-in-law), and other relatives and friends. Messrs. A. E. Wyatt made the arrangements.
