THE LATE MRS. A.M. GEARING

The death occurred at the Royal I.W. County Hospital on Tuesday of Mrs. Annie Maude Gearing, of 61 Furrongs, Pan Estate, aged 75. Mrs. Gearing had been in poor health since Christmas and had been in hospital for about a week. Her husband, Mr. Frederick William Gearing, died four years ago. Mrs. Gearing was born at Cowes, where she spent most of her life. She is survived by five daughters, three sons, and 15 grandchildren. The funeral takes place to-day, with a service at St. Paul's, at 2 p.m.
