FUNERAL OF MISS LAWRENCE. – The remains of Miss Lawrence, who for many years occupied the position of head milliner in the firm of Messrs. Pinnock and Sons, High-street, and who died last Thursday, after only about six hours' illness, were interred in Newport cemetery on Tuesday morning. The funeral *cortege* left the High-street premises about eleven o'clock, amid all the manifestations of public regard for the deceased lady, who was highly respected. The polished elm coffin, placed upon a hearse of modern design, having the sides open, was exposed to the full view of the large crowd of persons through which the procession passed. Upon the coffin were numerous wreaths sent by friends. Mr. Robert Pinnock and four sons, as well as several employees of the firm, followed. The bell of St. Thomas's tolled the funeral knell as the carriages moved down the High-street to the Newport cemetery. The whole of the service was read at the grave by the Rev. J. Harrison, in the unavoidable absence of the Rev. H. J. Tresidder (Castlehold Baptist Church), and at the close of the solemn ceremony a large number of persons lingered near the grave to take a last look at the coffin containing one who was so highly esteemed. The funeral arrangements were satisfactorily conducted by Mr. Bevis, High-street.
