NEWPORT

THE FUNERAL- of Mrs. McQueen, wife of J. A. McQueen, Red Lion Inn, whose death occurred on Tuesday, took place at Newport Cemetery yesterday (Friday), the first part of the service being held at St. Thomas's Church, the Rev. J. L. Spratt officiating. The chief mourners were the deceased's husband, Mrs. Thorpe, Mrs. Ash, and Mrs. Whittle (daughters), Mr. Ash and Mr. Whittle (sons-in-law), and Mrs. D. C. MacDonald (a personal friend). Messrs. N. H. T. Mursell, G. Norris, and L. J. McKinley were present, representing the Licensed Victuallers Society, and Mr. A. R. Shepard represented the Beatrice Lodge R.A.O.B. A number of floral tributes were sent. Mrs. McQueen had been more or less ailing since the early stages of the war, and latterly had been a great sufferer. Mr. H. W. Parnell was the undertaker.
