THE LATE MR. MILLIDGE. - The remains of this highly respected gentleman were interred in the Newport Cemetery on Monday morning, the Rev. Canon Connor, M.A., performing the service. Among those assembled round the grave were Messrs William, Thomas, Benjamin and Alfred Millidge (sons of deceased), Messrs James Eldridge (town clerk), John Lock, Richard Mew, W. Dudley, W. Gubbins, W. Carter, Charles Lock, Dr. Edward Waterworth, James Eldridge, jun. &c. Deceased was a staunch Conservative, and one who the party could ill afford to lose. He died in his 80th year, after being in business in the High-street for nearly 50 years, during which he was for a considerable time an auditor for the borough..
