**DEATH OF MRS. MORGAN.** – Much sympathy has been expressed with Mr. Fred Morgan, a former member of the Town Council and well-known tradesman, in the great loss he has suffered by the death of his wife, after a very short illness at their residence, Stuart House, Holyrood-street, on Saturday, at the age of 64.
