Death of Retired Painter.- The death occurred on Tuesday week of Mr. Alfred Lionel Newnham, aged 77, of 63 Hunnyhill. Mr. Newnham, who had lived on the Island all his life, was well known as a painter and decorator, working for some time for Messrs. Westbrook, of Cowes. During the first world war he served with the Royal Engineers in France and as a result of his injuries he lost a leg. Mr. Newnham was a member of the Old Contemptibles and the Newport branch of the British Legion. His wife died in 1947 and he is survived by four sons and a daughter. The funeral service was held on Tuesday at Pyle Street Methodist Church, conducted by the minister (the Rev. D. J. Creamer). The hymn "Abide with me" was sung and the mourners were Messrs. R. G. R. A., and H. Newnham (sons), and Mr. F. Saunders (son-in-law, also representing his wife). The interment followed at Newport Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
