**Death of Mr. J. A. A. Nobbs.**- The death occurred at Meaders Road, Ryde, on Wednesday, of Mr. John Arthur Ambrose ("Dick") Nobbs, aged 76, formerly of 15 Clifford Street. The son of the late Mr. Charles E. Nobbs, a former accountant to the County Council, he was employed in the County Council clerical department for over 50 years, and prior to the war was engaged on registration work. After his retirement he continued to work in a part-time capacity until last year. His wife died two years ago and he leaves two sons and a daughter. In his early days he was a skilful gymnast. The funeral service will be at St. Thomas's Church today at 3.30 p.m.
