DOUBLE BEREAVEMENT.- The death occurred on Friday week of Mrs. Kate Lucy Odell, aged 67, the wife of Mr. Arthur Henry Odell, of 12 Crocker Street, and yesterday (Friday) the family were doubly bereaved by the death of her husband, who was the same age as his wife. He had been employed by Messrs. W. B. Mew, Langton and Co. for many years, and was much respected. During his retirement he had not enjoyed good health, and he died after a long and painful illness very patiently borne. Much sympathy is felt with Miss Odell and Mr. and Mrs. W. Odell (son and daughter-in-law). The funeral of Mrs. Odell took place on Wednesday, the first part of the service being conducted in the Parish Church by the Vicar (the Rev. J. F. S. Glynn), and the interment following at Newport Cemetery. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. W. Odell (son and daughter-in-law), Messrs. F. Mew (brother), A. Mew (son), G. and W. Odell (brothers-in-law), Mrs. R. Andrews (sister), Mrs. Mew (sister-in-law), and Mr. and Mrs. Fruen (son-in-law and daughter). Mr. H. F. Odell, son of the deceased was unable to attend owing to having met with a serious accident in London. The arrangements were carried out by Mr. H Parnell. The funeral of Mr. A. H. Odell will take place on Tuesday, the first part of the service being held in the Parish Church at 2.30.
