Death of Well Known Tradesman.- The death occurred on Sunday of Mr. Frank Henry Rann, aged 69, of 102 Pyle-street, founder of the well known hairdressing business carried on at that address. He was the oldest hairdresser in the town and was much respected by many friends. He founded the business when only 18 years of age, and has carried it on ever since at the same address. Mr. Rann had been an invalid for some years, and his eldest son has managed the business. Mrs. Rann died six years ago. Two sons and two daughters survive him. The funeral was on Thursday, when the Vicar (the Rev. W. H. Mackinnon) officiated at the service in St. John's Church and at Newport Cemetery. The mourners were Messrs. H. and B. Rann (sons), Mrs. F. Leslie and Mrs. A. Howell (daughters), Mrs. B. Rann (daughter-in-law), Mr. A. Howell (son-in-law), Mr. A. Dove (brother-in-law), Mrs. W. Richards (representing Mrs. Snow), Miss Snow (niece), Miss Cartwright (sister-in-law), and Miss B. and Master R. Rann (grandchildren), Mrs. H. Rann and Mr. F. Leslie were unavoidably prevented from attending.
