DEATH OF MR. J. H. REED. – The death occurred on Saturday of Mr. Joseph Henry Reed, aged 66, of Fairlee-road. The son of the first manager of the local Gasworks [Joseph Reed], the deceased was for some years the collector of the Newport Gas Company, but for over 30 years he had been incapacitated from work by an increasingly painful affliction, which he bore with commendable patience. Although greatly handicapped in walking deceased was able to be out almost to the last, and his characteristic geniality survived throughout his trying illness. He was from his early days a member of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows. Much sympathy is felt for the widow and children in their bereavement. The funeral took place at the Newport Cemetery on Wednesday, the Rev. Miles Atkinson (vicar of St. Paul's, Barton) officiating. The mourners were the widow, Messrs. A. and H. Reed (sons), Mrs. L. Reed (daughter-in-law), Mrs. J. Love (sister-in-law), Messrs. H. and G. Love (brothers-in-law), Mrs. Blowers, and Mrs. Everton. Messrs. E. G. Barnes and W. D. W. Buckell were among others attending. There were no flowers by deceased's wish. The funeral arrangements were carried out by Messrs. Hamilton and Sons.
